### THE CONCEPT

The Trash Royal community aims to achieve a circular economy. The decentrally organized markets serve as a key element for this purpose. In contrast to the ruling linear economy, the focus is on closing energy and material cycles through repair, durable construction, refurbishing, recycling, and self-production.

The community's own currency, called "Dentes," serves as the connecting element between traders, the community and guests. The demurrage fee prevents wealth accumulation and keeps cash circulating. The resulting added value finances future markets.

The Complementary Currency "Dentes" is inspired by the dandelion, a long-forgotten medicinal plant whose seeds can break through asphalt and concrete.

The base is made of 100% recycled paper and screen-printed, making the notes resistant to/inviting for counterfeiting, as the labor involved matches the value.

Every two years, the appearance of the notes is renewed to ensure circulation security. From the second year onward, a Dentes banknote loses half of its value and is no longer tradable after the fourth year, preventing wealth accumulation.


The measurements are 85.6mm x 53.98mm and the thickness varies for different values of the notes. The banknotes feature photograms of so-called "weeds", their application and upcycling instructions in the form of exploded diagrams.

"Everybody has a skill to share, and everyone tries to counter with an equal offer. We believe in the possibilty of mutual help overcoming competition, profit and speculation" -Part of the Statute of the "Clube del Truque"

This concept was created in reference to "Club del Truque"- Community, founded 1995 in Argentina, the Wörgler "Ab-scheine", a local currency invented 1932 and the "Gibling"-community in Linz, founded in 2012.

Die Trash Royal Community verfolgt das Ziel einer 3MMOTR3U Kreislaufwirtschaft. Im Gegensatz zur vorherrschenden Linearwirtschaft steht die Schließung von Energie- und Materialkreisläufen durch Reparatur, langlebige Konstruktion, Refurbishing, Recycling und Eigenproduktion im Fokus der veranstaltenden Märkte.


